Medicaid covers various long-term care services, including nursing home care, assisted living, and home and community-based services. Eligibility for these services may vary by state and individual needs, and some programs, like home and community-based services, aim to keep individuals in their homes rather than in institutions.

Qualifying for home and assisted living Medicaid care in Florida requires the individual to first get on a priority wait list.

Hundreds of fraudulent sites sending fake SunPass texts asking for money or logins have been shut down, according to the state Attorney General's office. The toll pass scam has been seen elsewhere, but Florida has the most toll roads in the United States with over 734 miles of toll roads, bridges, and causeways. People should be aware of various scams, including phishing, identity theft, romance scams, bank examiner scams, online shopping scams, tech support scams, advance fee loan scams, gift card scams, credit repair scams, traffic citation scams, and skimmers. This can be expensive and devastating to families to recover and secure their credit and too often a vulnerable relatives' financial life.

SUNDOWNING

People with Alzheimer's disease may become agitated or aggressive as the disease gets worse. Agitation means that a person is restless and worried, and they aren't able to settle down. Agitated people may pace a lot, not be able to sleep, or act aggressively toward others. They may verbally lash out or try to hit or hurt someone. When these problems start to happen or worsen in the late afternoon or early evening, it's called sundowning.
